We offer a wide variety of AP Courses and our graduates earn admission into competitive universities, often receiving significant scholarship money. According a recent Washington Post report, only 19% of students in the United States receive college scholarships. However 63% of our graduates receive college scholarships to schools such as UNC Chapel Hill, NC State, High Point University, College of Charleston, Wake Forest, University of Miami, and Liberty University to just name a few. Intellectual curiosity is championed on campus, as we encourage students to develop academically.



More than two-thirds of our students participate in extra-curricular activities such as musical theatre, athletics and a variety of clubs and intramural activities. Our athletic programs are extremely competitive. In recent years our seniors have received full ride scholarships to Division I, Division II and Division III colleges. WSCS is a place to engage in multiple levels. In the classroom students are challenged by teachers to pursue engagement. Students are encouraged to be involved in student activities, the arts, and athletics as a way to develop all areas of an individuals life.

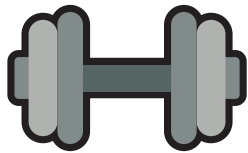
